



WEB SITES BREAK THE LAW

Many top UK web sites are breaking the law by not providing adequate access for disabled people, according to recent research. In web testing firm SciVisum's Web Accessibility Study, 79 percent of 216 firms failed basic accessibility checks. Deri Jones, chief executive at SciVisum, said web sites with poor accessibility are likely to lose custom to rivals.
